TEN ACRE EXEMPTION

Under Chapter 366.250 of the Texas Health and Safety Code, a person is exempt from **fees** for obtaining an on-site septic facility (OSSF) **permit** for residential purposes if:

- 1. The ten acre tract is in the applicant's name
- 2. There is only one residence on the tract

The Chapter further states that the following conditions do apply, and if not followed, the owner is subject to fines.

- 1. The OSSF must be installed to minimum state constructions standards and must be covered by a 2-year maintenance contract if an aerobic system is installed.
- 2. A licensed installer or the property owner must install the OSSF.
- 3. The owner must submit to the County Judge's Office an affidavit to the public, a site/soil evaluation and a design plan if installing an aerobic system.
- 4. A 100' buffer zone from property lines must be observed.
- 5. Testing and reporting forms shall be provided to the County OSSF office every four months.
