


REGULAR SESSION
October 11, 2022


The regular session of Commissioners' Court of Trinity County was held Tuesday October 11, 2022 at 9:00 am in the Commissioners Courtroom, 162 West 1st street, Trinity County Courthouse, Groveton, Texas, with the following members present:

1. Judge Page called the meeting to order at 9:00 A.M. and noted that the agenda was properly filed and posted at 4:30 PM, October 6, 2022.
