Approval of a Service Agreement between the Centerville Water Supply Corp. and Trinity County outlining each party's responsibilities in a 2017-2018 Texas Community Development Block Grant program-Community Development Fund grant of up to \$275,000 to construct water system improvements, if such awarded by the Texas Department of Agriculture was made by a motion from Commissioner Smith and seconded by Commissioner Brown. Motion carried.

Approval of a Resolution that authorizes submission of an application to the Texas Department of Agriculture for a 2017-2018 Texas Community Development Block Grant program-Community Development Fund grant of up to \$275,000 to construct water system improvements and designate the Trinity County Judge as the County's authorized signatory was made by a motion from Commissioner Smith and seconded by Commissioner Brown. Motion carried.
