How to read your meter



The following is an example of how to read a typical meter index.

Look at the four dials with their curved arrows. Read from right to left as follows:

- 1. Read the "thousand-foot" dial as 7, the last number that the pointer passed. Note that the curved arrow on the dial shows a clockwise movement of the pointer.
- 2. Read the next dial, the "IO-thousand" dial. The curved arrow on the dial above shows a

counterclockwise direction. The pointer is near the 9, but to be sure whether to read it as that number or the lower number 8, the previously mentioned "same or lower number rule" must be applied. Since the pointer in the "thousand-foot" dial to the right is nearer the 8 and the pointer has not reached the 0, the "IO-thousand" dial should be read as 8.

- 3. Read the "IOO-thousand" dial, it seems to point to 2. Double-check by using the rule above. Since the pointer of the "IO-thousand" dial is between 8 and 9, take the tower reading number, 1, for the "IOO-thousand" dial.
- 4. Read the left-most dial, the "million-foot" dial. The pointer is near the 6. Using the "same or lower number rule", we find the pointer on the dial to the right is between 1 and 2, so we read the "million-foot" dial exactly as the number it is on or near, 6.

The entire meter reading is 6187.







- 1. Read the "thousand-foot" dial as 7, the last number that the pointer passed. Note that the curved arrow on the dial shows a clockwise movement of the pointer.
- 2. Read the next dial, the "IO-thousand" dial. The curved arrow on the dial above shows a

counterclockwise direction. The pointer is near the 9, but to be sure whether to read it as that number or the lower number 8, the previously mentioned "same or lower number rule" must be applied. Since the pointer in the "thousand-foot" dial to the right is nearer the 8 and the pointer has not reached the 0, the "10-thousand" dial should be read as 8.

- 3. Read the "IOO-thousand" dial, it seems to point to 2. Double-check by using the rule above. Since the pointer of the "IO-thousand" dial is between 8 and 9, take the lower reading number, 1, for the "IOO-thousand" dial.
- 4. Read the left-most dial, the "million-foot" dial. The pointer is near the 6. Using the "same or lower number rule", we find the pointer on the dial to the right is between 1 and 2, so we read the "million-foot" dial exactly as the number it is on or near, 6.

The entire meter reading is 6187.
